



# STREET ART 101: HOW TO MAKE A WHEAT PASTE POSTER

## MAKING THE WHEAT PASTE









(1) MEASURE OUT A 1:4 RATIO OF WHEAT FLOUR/WATER AND PLACE THEM IN SEPARATE CONTAINERS.





(2) APP WATER TO POT

- 3 DAGE THE WATER REACHES BOILING, POUR WHEAT FLOUR INTO POT AND STIR THOROUGHLY, MAKE SURE YOU PON'T HAVE ANY FLOUR BALLS OR CLUMPS IN THE MIXTURE.
- 4)ONCE THE WHEAT PASTE REACHES A SMOOTH AND GLUE-LIKE CONSISTENCY, TURN OFF HEAT AND POUR THE PASTE INTO A SEPARATE CONTAINER.



KADD A LITTLE SUGAR FOR EXTRA STICKINESS \* USE THE WHEAT PASTE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. IF YOU PLAN ON WAITING A PAY OR TWO, STORE IN REFRIGERATOR.


